2024-25 St. Jerome Early Childhood Center Re-enrollment and Application Process:

Application packets for currently enrolled two and three-year olds will come home January 25/26. If you are currently enrolled and will have a new sibling entering our program next year, please call the office to request a packet. All students, including those currently enrolled, who plan to attend St. Jerome ECC for the 2024-25 school year will need to apply or reenroll as outlined below. St. Jerome ECC is currently participating in the state Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) program for four year olds. Our ECC families can assist St. Jerome ECC by spreading the word to other families with preschool age children. Let friends, family, and neighbors know that we have an Open House on Sunday, January 28th from 10:30am – 12:00pm.

Families are reminded that our policy does not allow teacher requests or requests to place certain children together. All families are asked to respect this long-standing, important policy and not approach any ECC staff members on this subject. Everyone's cooperation is most appreciated as we have faith in each and every one of our educators and expect the same from all families who have chosen St. Jerome ECC.

Feb. 5 – Registration begins for currently enrolled children and siblings.

Feb. 12 – Open Registration – All are welcome!

Our two-year-old program is offered two (TTH), three (MWF), or five (M-F) mornings.

Our three-year-old program is offered two (TTH), three (MWF), or five (M-F) mornings. Students must be three years of age by September 1, 2024 and **fully independent** with toileting skills.

Our four-year-old program is offered five days (M-F).

Extended Day is available for all ages, mornings beginning at 8:00am and afternoons until 3:00pm.

Re-enrollment opens as of <u>8:00am</u> on Monday, February 5. <u>PARENTS MUST SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT AND COME</u> into the office with all paperwork completed (the exception would be for the VPK Certificate of Eligibility – you CAN register <u>if you have applied to VPK</u> but have not received your certificate yet), registration fees, and required signatures. <u>No application/re-enrollment forms will be accepted prior to that time</u>. <u>Please do not send these items in through the children's backpacks</u>. Information regarding appointment times will be sent to you soon via email.

All fees must be current prior to registration/re-enrollment. *Families that might have a difficulty in this area are asked to contact the ECC office prior to registration.

Four Year Old/VPK Families:

The 2024-25 VPK Application is now available. You will need to create a Family Portal Account (if you do not already have one). You can reach the Family Portal by selecting VPK from the following link: https://elcpinellas.net/
Families will then receive a Certificate of Eligibility (via email) which will be part of your registration paperwork due to St. Jerome ECC. St. Jerome ECC established a pledge drive for those families attending our VPK program. Families are asked to consider pledging a financial amount that will help offset the difference between what the state is providing per child for the VPK program and what the actual cost is for the nationally accredited, quality ECC program that St. Jerome ECC provides. Families will receive a pledge letter and response card in their registration/ packets. Your participation is optional, but your consideration is greatly appreciated and needed for our center to remain in the VPK program. St. Jerome ECC has participated in the VPK program since its first year in 2005 and increases from the state have been minimal, and some years, no increase at all. Our center employs highly qualified, faith-filled educators to work with your children. Additionally, St. Jerome ECC allows families to enroll for just the VPK portion of the day, which many schools/centers do not allow.

St. Jerome ECC is self-supporting through parent tuition and fundraising events. Our center seeks to offer a quality program, affordable to families seeking a Catholic educational setting for their children.

Kindergarten Information:

- ♦ Kindergarten for the 2024-25 School Year: We sent a Kindergarten Information packet home to our 4-year-old students and will continue to share registration information as it becomes available. All ECC families are strongly encouraged to consider our local Catholic Elementary Schools for your child's transition to kindergarten. Visit the Diocese of St. Petersburg Office of Catholic Schools & Centers website http://dosp.org/schools/ to view the various Catholic Schools offering kindergarten. Scholarships are available − see details on the above website under Financial Aid and note that applications for financial aid are time sensitive. Be sure to check out our Catholic Elementary Schools during Catholic Schools' Week, when all Catholic schools host open houses and special events. Private schools now have offer Step Up Scholarships to all families regardless of their financial situation.

REMINDERS

- ♦ **2024-25 Survey:** A survey is being sent to all current families this week. Please indicate your needs and preferences for the upcoming school year. We will take this information into account when making our preparations for staffing, program hours, etc. Surveys are due back to the school office by January 19th. Thank you!
- ♦ No School: St. Jerome ECC will be closed Monday, January 15th in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- Child Car Seat Restraint Law: Reminder that all children ages 4 and 5 are required to sit in a child safety seat or a booster seat rather than only being buckled in a seatbelt.
- ◆ **Tuition** Tuition payments are due the first of each month. Payments made after the 10th of the month are considered late and need to include the appropriate late fee.
- Appropriate Shoes: Parents are asked to refer to the Family Handbook with regards to appropriate shoes for school.
 No boots, crocs or sandals are allowed for safety reasons.
- **Belongings:** Parents are asked to label all of their child's belongings that are brought to school. Lunch boxes, jackets and hats can easily be lost if not properly labelled.
