


# Back-to-School Night

#### FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

- Vision Screenings: Screenings by Preserve Vision will be conducted Tuesday, September 19 and Wednesday, September 20, 2023. All students are eligible for this free service but must submit a permission slip no later than Friday, September 15. You will receive detailed information in your child's backpack next week. Thank you.
- Parent-Teacher Conferences: St. Jerome ECC hosts formal conferences twice each school year. The purpose of our first conference is to give our parents and teachers the opportunity to meet with one another and share how the children are adjusting to the new school environment. Our fall conferences will be held on Friday, October 13 (children will not attend school on this day). All parents are asked to sign up for their conference via Sign-Up Genius. You will receive an email to sign in mid-September. You will also receive an email confirming your conference time. If you do not receive the sign-up email, please contact the ECC office.
- Enrichment Classes: These are afternoon classes available to our EC3 and EC4/VPK students only. We are beginning enrichment classes this month! Stretch n Grow will offer Music, Sports and Dance. Coach Lexi will be present at our Back to School night to explain a little more about their wonderful program. Families may enroll at <u>www.SNG-STPETE.com</u>. Families must register and pay for Extended Care for that afternoon. Contact the office if you are interested in having your child join. Our SJECC staff will offer enrichment classes too! These are available at no extra cost only the extended care fee will apply. Mondays will be Spanish with Mrs. Pollock and Fridays will be Kidding Around Yoga with Mrs. Kayleigh. Call the office for more details.
- **Classroom Family Directories**: Classroom Directories are available on our Brightwheel under Paperwork Shared Files. Use this for contacting other families but never for solicitation.
- Weekly Notes from Classroom Teachers: Families receive Weekly Classroom Notes each Friday via the Brightwheel app. Each teacher includes a recap of all the wonderful things that happened in that week as well as details for the upcoming week or month, allowing families to have awareness of topics, skills, literature, themes, etc. that will be introduced in each particular classroom. Families may want to expand upon these lessons or use the notes to spark conversations with your child about their day. A more detailed lesson plan is posted outside each classroom door on Mondays outlining additional happenings for the week ahead.
- **Communication Folders**: Each classroom has set up a Communication Folder for each child that comes home to families every day for communication purposes. Please feel free to correspond with your child's teacher in this daily folder. On the last day of the week, the folder will contain important papers and information. Please review the items in the folder. Please take out the items each week and review them to stay current with all school happenings. Please return the folders to your child's teacher on the first day his/her school week.
- PCLB Required Forms: The Pinellas County Licensing Board has two required forms that will need your signatures this month. The distracted Driver and Flu brochures are posted in Brightwheel for you to read. Next week in carline, we will collect your signature on a separate form to acknowledge that you read the two brochures. Thank you in advance.
- Four Year Olds: Our four-year old classes receive an "On Track to Kindergarten" activity sheet and letter of the week page in their Communication folder each Friday (beginning this week). These "homework" pages will come home to extend skills introduced at school and offer families ways to work together on developmentally appropriate experiences. (It is not required that the page be returned but children are more than welcome to show their teacher their work!)

#### REMINDERS:

- Car Line Safety: For our carline to function safely and efficiently, please have your child's car seat on the side closest to our building, do not pass, do not park by the pond and walk through carline. Do pull to another part of campus to securely buckle your child. Do be patient with us and with one another. We appreciate it!
- Illness: Please do not send your child to school if he or she has any signs of illness. Please report all absences to the office. Do not return to school unless fever-free (without medication) for 48 HOURS. Thank you for helping us keep all our students healthy!
- Children's Birthdays: Individual children will be recognized by their teachers on their birthdays, but treats are not allowed to be sent to school for children's birthdays. Families are invited to come to their child's classroom on their birthday to read a book or play a game with the class. *If interested in doing this, please contact the ECC office or coordinate with your child's teacher.* When inviting St. Jerome ECC children to an individual child's birthday, invitations may be sent home through school, only if <u>all</u> children in that class are invited. Parents are asked to give those invitations to the classroom teacher who will distribute the invitations.
- Extended Day Billings: Invoices for "as needed" Extended Day will come home via email the first week of each month for the previous month's use. Additional details can be found in your Family Handbook. Routine and as needed fees are due on the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month. A \$25 late fee will be accrued after the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- St. Jerome ECC Website: Families are reminded that school calendars, newsletters, and other current information can be accessed on our website at <a href="https://www.stjeromeecc.org/">https://www.stjeromeecc.org/</a>. (Paper copies are available on request.)
- ◆ St. Jerome ECC T-Shirts: St. Jerome ECC has T-shirts (\$10) available in the center office. We wear these on Mondays (Tuesdays for our T/TH students) and special event days. New this year we have tote bags! They are \$10 and perfect for students or adults.

- Monthly Calendars: Monthly ECC Calendars will be sent home and posted on our website each new month. Please refer to the calendars for events and deadlines.
- Inclement Weather: St. Jerome ECC follows the Office of Catholic Schools and Centers (<u>https://www.dosp.org/</u>) with regards to school closures in severe weather. At times, we may reopen before the county system, as often public schools are used as shelters. In those cases, families will be contacted.
- **Parent Library:** St. Jerome ECC has a growing Parent Library that includes books and other parenting materials available for parent to checkout. Topics include: Faith development, parenting, school-readiness, nutrition, siblings, etc.
- Extended Care: Extended Care is available every morning beginning at 8:00 am and every afternoon until 3:00 pm.
- Emergency Drills: Fire Drills will be held each month as required. We had our first drill, and it was a success. The teachers prepared students with lessons about fire safety, and they did a wonderful job lining up and reporting to their stations in a quick and orderly manner. Other emergency drills such as tornado and lockdown will be practiced in the future. These are required safety measures but are always presented in a developmentally appropriate manner for our students with their emotional well-being in mind.
- Nutritional Information: Nutritional guidelines and specific guidelines for those staying for lunch can be found in your Welcome Packet and on the ECC Website. Please review these items and help us encourage good eating habits for our students. Please remember to pack your child's lunch separate from his/her snack. Snack should be in a labeled container and should contain two food groups (per PCLB). Please no gummies, candy, soda, fast-food or choking hazards.
