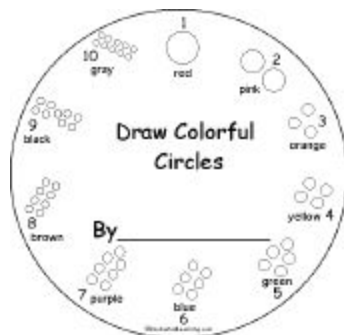

**Coffee Filter Butterflies** “Materials Needed: Round, white coffee filters; pipe cleaners; markers; eye droppers; water. The children color the coffee filter. The more they color it the better!

They then drop water onto the filters. This will spread the color out and make some pretty remarkable looking color collages. When dry, pinch filter in the middle and wrap a piece of pipe cleaner on the pinched part.” from [PreschoolPlan-It.com](http://PreschoolPlan-It.com)
